

From the Principal

This Friday is a 'School Development Day,' and therefore no students attend. The purpose of these days is for school staff to take part in professional learning or planning. There are six of these days throughout the year, with all schools using two days at the start of the year before students commence, and one day at the end of the year after students have finished. The other three days are left for schools to choose the dates, in consultation with their school boards. We chose this Friday, as it backs onto a long weekend, and historically we have had a lot of students absent on this day, travelling with family. The day has been dedicated to professional learning focused on the teaching of Mathematics. The subject of Mathematics equates to about 30% of our teaching time and we have the desire to improve how we teach it. We have input from a highly accredited Math's teacher to guide us. The two remaining School Development Days will take place on Monday 21st July, prior to commencement of Term 3, and Friday 26th September (last day of term 3).

Last Tuesday (18th February) was our 'Welcome Evening.' The main purpose of the event is for teachers to conduct a meeting to inform parents about their child's classroom and education program. We had 40% of families attend. If you haven't had the opportunity to meet your child's teachers as yet, then I encourage you to arrange a time to do so. Knowing your child's teacher and having clear communication, can only be of further benefit to your child's school year.

Speaking of communication, do you have access to the school's new communication tool 'Compass?' Erin has sent a link, via your email address, to enrol in this. It's far more user friendly then the previous 'Connect.' If you're having difficulty getting enrolled, call into the front office or give us a call, and we can assist. It will be our key communication tool for the year, to keep you informed and for you to inform us.

Finally, school attendance has begun reasonably well, with an attendance rate of over 91%. This is a big step up from a pretty miserable rate of 87% last semester. Every day counts!

Parent Communication

At the end of last year, North Kalgoorlie PS transitioned to a new attendance system. This system from the Department of Education also includes parent communication.

North Kalgoorlie PS will no longer be using Connect for parent communication and have transitioned to the new system for 2025.

We now use Compass School Manager as our Parent Portal. Using our Parent Portal you will be able to:

- View up-to-date class and school attendance information
- Approve or enter upcoming or past absences for your child
- Update your registered email and mobile number (used for SMS alerts) details
- Access information regarding upcoming events and news
