North Kalgoorlie Primary School has a rich history dating back to 1902. In 2002, as part of our centenary celebrations, a bell and stand was kindly donated by several families. Now, as a first day tradition, the Year Ones ring the bell at the start of the year to mark their commencement at our school. The next time they ring the bell will be as a Year Six student. This will mark their leaving North Kalgoorlie Primary School for secondary education. This year, 64 Year One students were welcomed into the fold.



Parent Communication

At the end of last year, North Kalgoorlie PS transitioned to a new attendance system. This system from the Department of Education also includes parent communication.

North Kalgoorlie PS will no longer be using Connect for parent communication and have transitioned to the new system for 2025.

- Update your registered email and mobile number (used for SMS alerts) details
- Access information regarding upcoming events and news

We are looking forward to being your councillors this year. Here are a few reminders to start off the term.

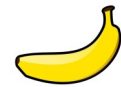
We would like to remind everyone to wear a bucket hat at school.
